

Horse Show Itinerary

Location: Plantation Acres Equestrian Center

Thursday:

- Everyone is welcome (but not required) to help unload the trophy trailer and set up the tack stall, horse stalls, and seating area.
- Set up will be between 4-6 pm (please confirm with instructor).
- Please make sure to schedule your ride time for Friday with Chelsie.

Friday:

- Horses will be shipped to the horse show by or before noon.
- Please show up 15 minutes before your ride time to groom and tack up.
- All riders are responsible for knowing the name of the division they are showing in and their class numbers.
- · All horses and tack must be thoroughly cleaned before leaving.
- Help with stall cleaning is appreciated.
- Help with filling water buckets is appreciated.
- All riders must know their back numbers. Back numbers are to remain in the tack room, so they are not forgotten at home.
- Any entry changes or add-ons must be made before 5 pm.

Saturday/Sunday:

- Please arrive in riding show pants! (Unless you are showing later in the day). A pair of long loose pants to pull over riding pants to keep them clean until show time is advised.
- You may change into a show shirt at the horse show.
- Please wear sneakers or old barn boots. Your show boots should be clean and put on before mounting your horse.
- Bring a change of clothes to change into after you show. This is to ensure your show cloths stay clean and stain-free for the next show!
- If your child is being dropped off or left to watch the remainder of the show, please inform the instructors. Please leave your child with some cash for the concession stand if they get hungry.
- All ribbons are collected near the arena in which the division took place. Trophies and medals are collected near the office.
- We suggest keeping track of placings and writing the date and class name on the back of each ribbon to look back on.
- If a groom is hired, tips are appreciated but not required.
- There will be a zero-bullying policy. Everyone is expected to be kind and helpful to one another.
- All students must understand you will not win every time, but we will come out with new things to learn and work on at home to do better in the future.
- The judge's cards are available to review in the office. Reviewing with your instructor is advised.

Please try to take photos with awards before untacking your horse and changing your clothes! Cherish the memories

Class times:

- Young Hunter ring start time is 7:45 am / 8 am
- Lead line riders must arrive by 7 am
- Walk/ Trot riders must arrive by 6:45 am
- Open walk/trot riders must arrive by 7:30 am
- Beginning Cross rail riders must arrive by 8 am
- Junior/ Adult beginning cross rail riders must arrive by 9 am
- Cross rail riders must arrive by 10 am
- Open beginning riders must arrive by 11 am
- Short stirrup riders must arrive by 12 pm
- Novice riders must arrive by 1 pm.
- Main hunter ring and jumper riders check with the instructor.

Please note, that these arrival times may change based on the number of entries at the show. Please check in with instructors Friday and Saturday afternoon to get a more accurate arrival time. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to show up early and or stay later to support the rest of the team!

Sunday Evening:

- All entry fees must be paid in the show office after the conclusion of the division the rider showed in. Mention Myrland and the rider's name so they can locate your invoice.
- Any open invoices will be paid by Myrland, we charge a \$25 processing fee and will add the invoice from the show to your Myrland Stables show invoice.
- Following the show's conclusion, we will begin packing up and loading the Trophy trailer along with all our trophies won! (Help is appreciated but not required).
- Following the trophy trailer we will load the horses in the horse hauler.
